**NECF CALLS FOR IMMEDIATE INVESTIGATION OF ALL PARTIES INVOLVED
IN ENFORCED DISAPPEARANCE OF PASTOR RAYMOND KOH AND AMRI CHE
MAT**

The National Evangelical Christian Fellowship (NECF) expresses its appreciation to the panel of the Malaysian Human Rights Commission (Suhakam) for the extensive and detailed inquiry and well-considered findings that were made with regards to the enforced disappearances of Pastor Raymond Koh on February 13, 2017 and Perlis-based activist Amri Che Mat on Nov 24, 2016.

NECF is gravely concerned that the direct and circumstantial evidence revealed in Pastor Raymond Koh and Amri Che Mat's cases proves that they were "abducted by State agents, namely, the Special Branch, Bukit Aman, Kuala Lumpur".

NECF enjoins the Attorney General and the Prime Minister, following the panel's clear and definite findings, to set up a Special Task Force to investigate the enforced disappearances of Pastor Raymond Koh and Amri Che Mat. All forms of dereliction of duty must be exposed and the grieving families be immediately informed of the whereabouts and well-being of the victims.

In this country, we uphold the Federal Constitution together with the freedoms and rights guaranteed under it as well as the rule of law. PDRM or their officers cannot be allowed to do as they like without following the rule of law. It will create chaos, disorder and disharmony in our country. Hence, we strongly urge and plead with the Pakatan government in this new Malaysia to immediately act on this heinous injustice.
