As we synergize our efforts, may we see families restored, may the families of the church be salt and light in their respective communities, and may we see homes increasingly marked by the redemptive grace of God.

ABOUT NATIONAL FAMILY SEASON INITIATIVE

The National Family Season (NFS) initiative is a part of the strategic plan of Family Ministries Malaysia and NECF Family Commission to create awareness in the Malaysian Church on the importance of building healthy families.

1. The Goal

Our overall long-term goal for the annual NFS is to see that it becomes an integral part of the yearly ministry calendar of the Malaysian Church.

2. Annual Key Focus

Each week during the NFS shall be devoted to one key area of Malaysian family life.

As marriage is the foundation of every family, we will make this the one-week focus in 2017.

FAMILY SEASON PROGRAMMES

1. NFS Programmes

We are suggesting the following nationwide programmes for 2017. More details of each are given in Section C below.

- **Celebrating the Mother's Day and Father's Day** with a focus on biblical motherhood and fatherhood. This could include carrying out related activities in conjunction with these celebrations.
 - **Family Blessings Week.** We are using the United Nations' International Day of Families on 15 May to start the week, focusing on cultivating the culture of setting regular times aside in the home to bless each other through prayers and other means.



- **Sexual Purity Week.** The focus is on seeking to please God in our sexual identity and life whether single or married, pastor or layperson, male or female, young or old.
- **Faith Legacy Week**. This is a week of commitment to passing faith on from one generation to another that the people of God may live long on the earth.
- Marriage Week. With an emphasis on couples making time for each other to build a close lifelong marriage relationship.
- Local Church Programme. We are encouraging individual churches, if they are able to do so, to organise other activities that could further contribute to the building of healthy families in their midst.

2. Church and Home Involvements a. Location

MOTHER'S DAY

Focus: Mothers – an image of God's nurturing heart.

Mother's Day.

Ideas:

Preach a sermon on motherhood,

i.e. Proverbs 31:10-31, selections from Proverbs on "mothering," mothers of faith in the Bible or from life testimonies, practical ways to be a godly mother, etc. Preaching should emphasize how to be a godly mother and not mere theory/head knowledge.

Have children sit with parents. During service, get husband and children to surround their wife/mother to express/speak out their gratitude, ask for forgiveness, and bless and pray for their wife/mother.

- Give a small gift (i.e. a rose) during service.
- Family members are encouraged to intentionally spend more time with their mothers for the whole week.
- Pastor can pray for mothers.
- A lunch for families to celebrate at the church premise.



FAMILY BLESSINGS

Focus: To set aside moments during the week to bless one another in the home. Commit to continuing this practice beyond this one week.

Family members can pray for other needs as appropriate.

12-17/6	 Daily Prayers Pray for each father or grandfather that Fathers will be their children's "first teacher" (Prov 22:6; Deut 6:6-9) God will give fathers grace to raise their children in faith and not to provoke them into anger (Eph 6:4) Fathers will become patriarchs over a clan that loves and serves the Lord in this nation and beyond.(Prov 17:6) God will bestow grace on fathers whose marriages are in crisis and single fathers as they continue to raise their children.
